A household with an elderly person or a person receiving disability payments only has to meet the net income test. Households are considered income-eligible if everyone in the household receives Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). Income limits vary by household size and may change each year.

You can ask your health care provider about getting a 90-day supply vs. a 60- or 30-day supply.
