The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1963, volume 4 Witness Lee 2021-05-28 The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1963, volume 4, contains the messages and fellowship given by Brother Witness Lee from September 4 through December 31, 1963. In the first part of September Brother Lee spent a few days ministering to the saints in Las Vegas, Nevada. There are indications that he also passed through Albuquerque, New Mexico, for a few days afterward; however, there is no record of his speaking during that time. On the weekend of September 20 and 21 he ministered to the saints in Tyler, Texas, and toward the end of the month he traveled to New York City, where he ministered for more than two weeks. In the month of November Brother Lee returned to Texas for a week to release messages in Tyler and Dallas. The following weekend he stopped briefly in Los Angeles and then traveled up the West Coast to Sacramento and San Francisco, California, giving weeklong conferences in both cities. In December Brother Lee again returned to Los Angeles,

where he ministered until the end of the year, sometimes speaking two or three times a day. The contents of this volume are divided into twelve sections, as follows: 1. Four messages given in Las Vegas on September 4 through 7. These messages were published under the title Contacting the Lord, Being Filled in Spirit, and Having Proper Christian Meetings for the Accomplishment of God's Eternal Purpose. There are indications, but no solid evidence, that the last message was given in Albuquerque, New Mexico. 2. Three messages given at a conference in Tyler on September 20 and 21. These messages are included in this volume under the title Experiencing Christ as Life for Our Transformation into His Image. Records indicate that originally four messages were given, but the last two, which were given on the same day and at the same location, were combined into one message. 3. Four messages given at a conference in New York City from September 29 through October 6. These messages are included in this volume under the title The Practical Way to Fulfill God's Eternal Purpose. 4. Four messages given at a

conference in New York City on October 11 through 13. These messages were published under the title *The Exercise of Our Spirit for the Release of the Spirit*. 5. A series of twelve messages given in the Tyler and Dallas area on November 7 through 15. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Being Transformed for the Practice of the Church Life*. 6. Three messages given in Tyler at various times during the month of November. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Fulfillment of God's Purpose and the Defeat of God's Enemy*. 7. Six messages given at a conference in Sacramento on November 22 through 25. These messages were published under the title *Experiencing Christ as the Inner Life*. 8. Eleven messages given in San Francisco from November 28 through December 1. These messages were published under the title *The Relationship of God with Man in God's New Creation*. 9. Messages given on two Lord's Days, November 17 and December 15, in Los Angeles. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Lord's Day Messages in Los Angeles*. The second message was divided into two parts. 10. Three messages constructed from personal notes of Brother Lee's fellowship with the leading ones on December 14 and 20 in Los Angeles. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Fellowship with the Leading Ones*. 11. Sixteen messages given at a conference in Los Angeles on December 22 through 31. These messages were published under the title *The Life and Way for the Practice of the Church Life*. 12. One message given at a meeting in Los Angeles on December 28. This message is included in this volume under the section title *Fellowship concerning the Body of Christ*. There are indications that this message was one in a series of informal talks that Brother Lee gave during the conference held on December 22 through 31. Records of the other talks were not available for publication.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1954, volume 1 Witness Lee Brother Witness Lee traveled to Manila, Philippines, at the beginning of 1954. On January 24 he began a seven-day perfecting conference with five special fellowships concerning the subject of pursuing the Lord. After this, he initiated a service training that lasted for six months, with four meetings per week. On Wednesday mornings he gave a Bible study

of the Old Testament, and on Wednesday evenings he gave a training on character, including matters such as being the proper person, handling affairs properly, and doing the proper work. On Friday mornings he gave a training on being a minister of God's word, and on Friday evenings he ministered on the proper way to meet. The number who attended these meetings varied between fifty-six and one hundred sixty. The study of the Old Testament and the training on character are included in volume 1 of the 1954 set, along with other messages given in the same time period. Brother Lee left Manila in July and traveled to Hong Kong, where he conducted ten meetings on life and twelve meetings on service, plus four gospel meetings, four young people's meetings, six fellowships on service, and six meetings for the full-time serving ones. These meetings were centered on the indwelling Christ and on the knowledge of spiritual service. They are included in volumes 1 and 2 of this set. Brother Lee left Hong Kong to return to Taiwan in the middle of August. At the end of August and the beginning of September, Brother Lee conducted a special conference in Taipei, Taiwan, that consisted of ten meetings on the subject of spiritual reality, with between one thousand six hundred and two thousand six hundred in attendance. These messages are included in the section entitled *Spiritual Reality* in volume 2 of this set. In the fall of 1954 Brother Lee began another extended training for serving ones like the one that he carried out in the fall of 1953. During this training he conducted a detailed study on Genesis, Exodus, and Leviticus through Ezra. The messages given in this detailed study are included in volume 4 of this set. He also spoke further on the knowledge of life and the experience of life. These speakings and the speakings in the previous training in 1953 on the same subjects were combined to form the books *The Knowledge of Life and The Experience of Life* (see *The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1953, vol. 3*). During this training he also released messages published in *Gospel Outlines*, which are included in volume 3 of this set. The *Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1954, volume 1*, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee on January 1 through August 12, 1954. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry in 1954 can be found in the general preface that

appears at the beginning of this volume. The contents of this volume are divided into seven sections, as follows: 1. Two messages given in Manila, Philippines, on January 1 and 3. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Significance and Application of the Burnt Offering*. 2. Eight messages given in Manila, Philippines, on January 24 through 31. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Living and Service of the Burnt Offering*. 3. Twenty-four messages given in Manila, Philippines, in February through July. These messages are included in this volume under the title *A Record of a Bible Study on the Old Testament*. 7. Eight messages given in Hong Kong on July 16 through August 12. The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1959, volume 1 Witness Lee During the first few months of 1959, Brother Witness Lee's first wife was in the final stage of her terminal illness, and he spent most of his time

accompanying her. No conferences were held, and no messages were recorded during this period of time. His wife died on April 24. On May 26 through 30 Brother Lee began to have a series of meetings with the co-workers on a new direction of the work in Taiwan. His speaking during this period is included in the first part of volume 1 of this set. After this, on June 4 he traveled to Hong Kong and stayed for two days, during which time he had a brief meeting with some of the co-workers. He then traveled to the Philippines. There he released some messages on Christ and the church and conducted a Bible study on the Gospel of John. His speaking in the Philippines is included in volume 1 of this set. After his visit to the Philippines, he returned to Hong Kong at the end of July and conducted a two-week young people's conference on July 25 through August 9. At the end of this conference he held six question-and-answer sessions with co-workers and district serving ones. Brother Lee's speaking during his two visits to Hong Kong are included in volumes 1 and 2 of this set. On August 16 he returned to Taiwan and began planning for the new stage of the work in Taiwan. Beginning on September 20 he conducted six days of gospel meetings in the largest stadium in Taipei, with more than ten thousand in attendance. This was preceded by three preparation meetings and four follow-up gospel truth meetings. On October 5 he began a training on how to perfect new ones, which extended until January 22, 1960. His speaking in Taipei during the second half of 1959 is included at the end of volume 2 and in volumes 3 through 5 of this set. The *Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1959, volume 1*, contains messages, personal letters, and reports given or written by Brother Witness Lee in January through November 1959. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry in 1959 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of this volume. The contents of this volume are divided into six sections, as follows: 1. Personal letters and reports that were published in *Church News*, Issue Nos. 19 through 23 and 26 through 33, in January through November. These letters and reports are included in this volume under the same title. 2. Two messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, on May 26. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The New*

Direction of the Work. 3. Four messages given in Manila, Philippines, and Taipei, Taiwan, in 1959. The first three chapters were previously published in a book entitled Our Vision--Christ and the Church. Later, a fourth chapter was added based on notes taken by Brother K. H. Weigh. The four messages are included in this volume under the same title as the previously published book. 4. Twenty-eight messages given in Manila, Philippines, in the summer of 1959. These messages are included in this volume under the title Revelations in John: Seeing the Essential Significance of Life and Building. 5. Four talks given in Hong Kong in June through August. These talks are included in this volume under the title A Record of Several Talks in Hong Kong. 6. Six messages given in Hong Kong on July 25 through August 9. These messages, plus an appendix, are included in this volume under the title Experiencing God as Life to Live the Church Life.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1984, volume 5 Witness Lee The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1984, volume 5, contains messages and fellowship given by Brother Witness Lee on October 22 through December 20, 1984, on January 13 through December 7, 1985, and on June 2, 1986. From the middle of October until the middle of November, Brother Lee traveled to the Far East and ministered in Tokyo, Japan; Seoul, South Korea; Taipei, Taiwan; and Quezon City, Philippines. He returned to Anaheim, California, for a few days in the middle of November, and near the end of November he traveled to Irving, Texas, where he remained until the end of the year. The contents of this volume are divided into ten sections, as follows: 1. Three messages given in Seoul, South Korea, on October 22 through 24, 1984. These messages are included in this volume under the title Fellowship concerning the Practice of the Church Life. 2. Five messages given in Chinese in Taipei, Taiwan, on October 27 through November 4, 1984. They were translated and were previously published in a book entitled The All-inclusiveness and Unlimitedness of Christ and are included in this volume under the same title. 3. Five messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, on October 29 through November 2, 1984. These messages were translated from Chinese and were previously published in a book entitled Guidelines for

the Propagation of the Lord's Recovery and are included in this volume under the same title. 4. Thirteen messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, three of which were given on November 4 and 15, 1984, nine of which were given on January 13 through December 7, 1985, and one of which was given on June 2, 1986. These messages were translated from Chinese and are included in this volume under the title The Faithful and Diligent Spreading of the Truth--concerning the Publication Service. 5. Three messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, on November 5, 1984. These messages were translated from Chinese and edited into two chapters and are included in this volume under the title The Organic Service Needed for the Increase and Spread of the Church. 6. Ten messages given in Quezon City, Philippines, on November 6 through 11, 1984. They were previously published in a book entitled Truth, Life, the Church, and the Gospel--the Four Great Pillars in the Lord's Recovery and are included in this volume under the same title. 7. A message given in Anaheim, California, on November 18, 1984. This message is included in this volume under the title The Four Provisions Given by God to Saved Ones. 8. Two messages given in Irving, Texas, on November 24 and December 5, 1984. They are included in this volume under the title The Inheritance in the Lord's Recovery and the Way to Gain People as Revealed in the Bible. 9. Two messages given in Dallas and Irving, Texas, on December 8 and 15, 1984. These messages are included in this volume under the title The Three Parts of Man and the Dispensing of the Triune God. 10. Two messages given in Irving, Texas, on December 6 and 20, 1984. These messages are included in this volume under the title Meeting in Small Groups and Homes for the Functioning of All the Saints and the Preaching of the Gospel.

Brother Lee remained in Irving, Texas, during the first part of January 1989. He

returned to Anaheim, California, in the second week of January and remained there until the end of the third week. At the end of the month he visited Hacienda Heights and San Diego, California, and returned to Anaheim in the beginning of February. From the second week in February through the end of the month he visited San Francisco, San Jose, Sacramento, Pleasant Hill, Berkeley, and San Gabriel, California, before returning to Anaheim. At the end of the first week in March Brother Lee traveled to Taipei, Taiwan, and remained there until the end of the third week in March. He then visited Quezon City, Philippines, and Taichung and Kaohsiung, Taiwan, before returning to Taipei at the beginning of April. He remained in Taipei until the end of the third week in April and then visited Seoul, South Korea, and Tokyo, Japan, before returning to Anaheim in the middle of May. At the end of the third week in May Brother Lee visited Cleveland, Ohio, and Newton and Cambridge, Massachusetts, until the end of the first week in June. At that time he returned to Anaheim and remained there until the end of 1989. The contents of this volume are divided into fifteen sections, as follows: 1. A message given in Irving, Texas, on January 1. This message is included in this volume under the title *The Conclusion of the Book of Leviticus*. 2. Two messages given in Anaheim, California, in Chinese by telephone to gospel teams gathered in Taipei, Taiwan, on January 10 and November 21. Six messages given in Anaheim, California, on January 21 through October 16. The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1961-1962, volume 1 Witness Lee Brother Witness Lee began 1961 in the month of January by giving a conference to the church in Taipei, Taiwan, in which he released messages on the vision of the church, and by holding a series of meetings with the elders and the co-workers, in which he spoke on being in one

work under one leadership. After the conference, during four days of service meetings, he conducted two prayer meetings with the laying on of hands for the co-workers. From the end of January until the first part of April, Brother Lee held various meetings with co-workers and serving ones in the districts of the church in Taipei on various subjects related to coordination, the priesthood, prayer, changing the way of meeting, and how to lead the young people. On February 6 through 18 he held a conference for university students and high-school graduates over the winter school break. A summary of the contents of this conference is included in Church News in volume 1 of this set, but there is no detailed record of his speaking in this conference. On March 12 through 14 he conducted a three-day conference in Taipei and gave messages on the priesthood and God's building. These messages, along with a number of other messages, are included in volume 2 of this set in the section entitled The Priesthood and God's Building. At the beginning of April, Brother K. H. Weigh visited Taiwan and had private times of fellowship with Brother Lee. On April 11 Brother Lee traveled to the Philippines. During his time there he held a training for young brothers and sisters in Baguio on April 14 through 28. In this training he spoke on life and building in the book of Ezekiel, from Ezekiel 1, 37, and 47. On April 30 through May 19 he gave messages in Manila on the priesthood and prayer. At that time a spiritual storm was brewing in Manila in which the leading co-workers rebelled against Brother Lee's leadership in the work. On May 20 he traveled from the Philippines to Hong Kong and stayed for one week. During that time, beginning on May 21 he conducted a conference concerning the ministry of the priesthood. After his time in Hong Kong, Brother Lee returned to Taipei on May 27. In June Brother Lee gave a series of messages in Taipei on the subject of the exercise of the spirit and the building of God. On August 3 through 19, in the morning he held a conference in Taipei on Ezekiel, and in the evening he spoke on how God becomes man's enjoyment. At the end of October he traveled to Manila and remained there until the middle of December. At the end of November and the beginning of December, he held another conference in Manila on the book of Ezekiel. There is no record of his

speaking in this conference. The messages on Ezekiel given in Taipei in 1961, along with another series of messages on Ezekiel given in 1971 in Los Angeles, California, are included in the Life-study of Ezekiel and are not included in The Collected Works of Witness Lee. During his time in Manila he also conducted a study on the book of Galatians and gave messages on various other topics. There is no record of his speaking on these occasions. He departed from Manila on December 14 for the United States. Brother Lee remained in the United States from the middle of December 1961 through the entire year of 1962. He stayed mainly in New York City until March 1962, at which time he moved to Seattle, Washington. While he was in New York City, he held a series of special conferences on the weekends. During the same period of time, he also visited Washington, D.C., for two days on January 6 and 7 and San Francisco, California, for three days beginning on February 16. There is no record of his speaking in Washington, D.C. After moving to Seattle in March, Brother Lee visited the San Francisco Bay Area and held meetings on two occasions, in April and July. On August 31 through September 3 he conducted a conference in Los Angeles. More than thirty brothers and sisters from San Francisco and Sacramento, California, joined the conference. The subject of the conference was the experience of Christ for the building up of the church. On the last day of the conference many renewed their consecration to the Lord. During the time when Brother Lee was residing in Seattle, he met privately with a few Chinese students from the Far East together with twenty or thirty other Christians. On November 11 the saints in Seattle began to break bread. Although conferences had been planned in which he would speak in Taiwan, prior to these conferences Brother Lee received a clear leading from the Lord to not return to Taiwan but remain in the United States and begin the work of the Lord's recovery there. This was a significant turn in the move of the Lord in His recovery on the whole earth, especially in the spread of the recovery to the Western world. Around the third week in November, Brother Lee traveled from Seattle to San Francisco and Sacramento. After spending three days in Sacramento, he traveled to Los Angeles at the end of the month. There is

no record of his speaking in Sacramento. Beginning on December 22, Brother Lee conducted a ten-day conference on the all-inclusive Christ. This was the first major conference after the Lord initiated His recovery in the United States. The attendees at this conference included an American brother from New York City; three responsible brothers from Louisville, Kentucky; one sister from near Chicago, Illinois; five or six Caucasian brothers and sisters and two Chinese saints from Sacramento; more than twenty from San Francisco; plus the local saints and some Caucasian visitors. During this conference Brother Lee conducted four meetings each day, starting at 6:30 A.M. The second morning meetings and the evening meetings were on the subject of the all-inclusive Christ. The first morning meetings and the times of fellowship in the afternoon were on miscellaneous topics. The conference ended on the last day of the year and was followed by fasting and prayer that lasted past 1:30 the next morning. At the end of June Brother Lee returned to Anaheim and remained there until the first week in October. From the middle of October until the middle of November, Brother Lee traveled to the Far East and ministered in Tokyo, Japan; Seoul, South Korea; Taipei, Taiwan; and Quezon City, Philippines. He returned to Anaheim for a few days in

The first seven messages were given on December 4 through 11, 1962, and the remaining two messages were given on January 22 and 24, 1963. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *The Mystery of God and the Mystery of Christ* and are included in this volume under the same title. 4. Sixteen messages given in Los Angeles on December 22 through 31, 1962. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *The All-inclusive Christ* and are included in this volume under the same title. 5. Nine messages given in Los Angeles on December 24 through 31, 1962. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Lord's Recovery of the Expression of Christ by the Power of Resurrection and through the Overcoming Believers*. 6. Eight messages given during a conference in Los Angeles that began on December 22, 1962. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Knowledge and Experience of Christ in Ephesians and Colossians*. 7. A message given during a time of fellowship in Los Angeles on December 31, 1962. This message is included in this volume under the title *Fellowship concerning the First Day of the First Month of the Year*. **Miscellaneous Records of the Kuling Training (2)** Watchman Nee 1994-09-01 Watchman Nee's writings have become well known for their

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1969, volume 3 Witness Lee The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1969, volume 3, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee from July 17 through December 28, 1969.

Brother Lee remained in Los Angeles through the month of July until the end of August. He made a brief trip to San Francisco, California, and then rested nearly the entire month of September. At the beginning of October he visited San Francisco, California; and then traveled to Phoenix, Arizona; Mesa, Arizona; Albuquerque, New Mexico; Las Vegas, Nevada; and San Francisco, California; a second time. After returning to Los Angeles for one day in the middle of November, he visited Yorba Linda, California; Louisville, Kentucky; Toronto, Canada; East Hartland, Connecticut; Boston, Massachusetts; New York City; Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and Erie, Pennsylvania. He returned to Los Angeles at the end of December. Regrettably, there is no record of his speaking in Phoenix, Las Vegas, Louisville, Toronto, East Hartland, and Boston. The majority of his speaking in Pittsburgh and Erie was recorded in handwritten notes. The contents of this volume are divided into fourteen sections, as follows: 1. Twenty-six messages given in Los Angeles, California, from July 17 through August 21. These messages were previously published in a twenty-four-chapter book under the title *Christ and the Church Revealed and Typified in the Psalms*. 2. One message given in Los Angeles, California, on August 16. It is included in this volume under the title *An Additional Word in Response to Testimonies concerning Five Secrets of Life Revealed in Second Peter 1*. 3. Five messages given in Los Angeles, California, on August 22 through 24. The first four of these messages were previously published in *The Ministry* magazine, volume 2, numbers 4 through 7, April, May, June, and July

1998, and the fifth message was previously published in *The Ministry* magazine, volume 2, number 8, August/September 1998, as one section of a compilation of Brother Lee's speaking on migration during the years 1969, 1970, 1971, and 1972. The entire series of five messages previously published in *The Ministry* magazine appeared under the title *Migration in God's Move*. 4. One message given in Los Angeles, California, on November 16. This message is included in this section under the title *Fellowship on Migration*. 5. Seven messages given in San Francisco, California, from August 29 through September 1 and on October 3. They are included in this volume under the title *Exercising the Spirit and Walking according to the Spirit to Build Up the Church*. 6. Three messages given in Los Angeles, California, on August 21 and 22. They are included in this volume under the title *Denying Our Soul-life and the Living, Walking, and Abiding in Our Spirit for the Building Up of the Church*. 7. One message given in Los Angeles, California, on September 25. This message is included in this volume under the title *Helping the New Believers to Be Properly Grounded in Their Salvation and to Grow in Life*. 8. One message given in Mesa, Arizona, on October 15. It is included in this volume under the title *Needing to Live in Our Spirit in Order to Meet in the Proper Way*. 9. Six messages given in Albuquerque, New Mexico, on October 17 through 20. These messages are published in this volume under the title *Enjoying the All-inclusive Spirit in Our Human Spirit for the Building Up of the Church*. There is no record of the first two messages. 10. Four messages given in San Francisco, California, on November 7 through 9. They are included in this volume under the title *Fall Conference in San Francisco*. 11. Eight messages given in Yorba Linda, California, on November 27 through 30. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Two Trees in the Christian Life*. Two of the messages were combined. 12. Four messages given in New York City on December 18 through 21. They are included in this volume under the title *Enjoying and Ministering Christ for the Fulfillment of God's Purpose*. 13. One message given in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, on December 22. This message is included in this volume under the title *The Lord's Recovery of the Practice of the*

Church Life. Its contents were taken from the personal notes of an attendee. Brother Lee spoke two additional messages on December 23, but there is no substantial record of his speaking. 14. Thirteen messages given in Erie, Pennsylvania, on December 24 through 28. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Lord's Recovery of the Church Life*. Of the thirteen messages spoken, only two were recorded. The content of the remaining chapters was taken from the personal notes of a conference attendee. Some messages were combined to form the nine chapters in this section. In addition to the above, Brother Lee gave six messages in Los Angeles, California, on August 16 through 21. These messages, together with messages given in 1963 and 1965, were previously published in a book under the title *Our Human Spirit*. This book in its entirety is included in *The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1950-1951, volume 3*.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1950-1951, volume 1 Witness Lee Brother Lee arrived in Taiwan from mainland China in May 1949 and started the work there on August 1 of that year. He remained there until February 1950. During that time he conducted a three-month study of the crucial truths in the Scriptures (see volumes 3 and 4 of the 1932-1949 set). Up to the end of the year, four baptism meetings were conducted, and the number of saints increased from around thirty to over nine hundred. On February 16, 1950, Brother Lee traveled to Hong Kong to join Watchman Nee in the work. He stayed until April 1, at which time he returned to Taiwan. The messages released during this period are included in volume 1 of this set, in the section entitled *The Recovery of the Church according to the Pattern on the Mountain*. After returning to Taiwan, he continued to lead the church in preaching the gospel and perfecting the saints. A total of one thousand two hundred twelve people were baptized in that year on nine occasions. The church met in twelve homes (that is, districts), six of which were in the city of Taipei and six in the suburbs. Some of the messages given during that time are included in the sections *In Spirit, Not in Letter*; *The Pursuit of a Christian*; and *The Pure in Heart* (see volumes 1 and 2 of this set). He also conducted trainings for the serving ones, but no record has been found of these

trainings. On November 17, 1950, Brother Lee visited the Philippines for the first time and stayed for five and a half months, after which he returned to Taiwan on May 1, 1951. The only record of his speaking consists of a talk that he gave in January 1951 in Manila to those who wished to serve (see his personal notes and diaries in volume 2 of this set). After returning to Taiwan, Brother Lee stayed for only two months and returned to Manila quickly. From June 26 through July 24 he was in Manila and held an eight-day conference beginning on July 8. No record has been located of this conference. After returning to Taiwan from Manila, he held a conference on August 5 on "A Christianity of Religion versus a Christianity of Revelation." No record has been found of his speaking in this conference. On September 19 he visited Manila for the third time and did not return to Taiwan until the end of the year. The church in Manila was subdivided into four district meetings, and new arrangements were made in the way of the preaching of the gospel and the edification of new believers. In 1951, during his brief times in Taiwan in May, June, and August, there are records of some of his speakings. These are published in volume 3 of this set. *The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1950-1951, volume 1*, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee in 1950. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry during the period of 1950-1951 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of this volume. The contents of this volume are divided into three sections, as follows: 1. Thirty-eight messages given in Hong Kong in February and March 1950. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Recovery of the Church according to the Pattern on the Mountain*. 2. Ten messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, in April and May 1950. These messages first appeared in the periodical *The Ministry of the Word* in volume 4, numbers 6 and 7, and in volume 5, numbers 1 through 6 and 8 and 9. They were also previously published in Chinese in a book entitled *In Spirit, Not in Letter* and are included in this volume under the same title. 3. Eight messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, in the summer of 1950. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *The Pursuit of a Christian* and are included in this volume under the same title.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1960, volume 2 Witness Lee
The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1960, volume 2, contains messages given and articles and personal notes written by Brother Witness Lee in April through December 1960. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry in 1960 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of volume 1 in this set. The contents of this volume are divided into ten sections, as follows: 1. Nine messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, in April through August. Chapters 1 through 5 contain messages given in July and August, and chapters 8 and 9 contain messages given on April 1 and 2. The dates of the messages that constitute chapters 6 and 7 are unknown. All nine messages were previously published in a book entitled *The Sufficiency, Pursuit, and Learning of the Lord's Serving Ones* and are included in this volume under the same title. 2. Four messages given in a training for young people in Taipei, Taiwan, in April. These messages are included in this volume under the title *God's Plan and Christ's Redemption*. 3. Three sets of personal notes written in 1960, probably beginning on April 26. These notes are included in this volume under the title *Witness Lee's Personal Notes*. 4. Fifteen messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, in 1960; the exact dates are unknown. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *The Elders' Management of the Church* and are included in this volume under the same title. 5. A message given in Taipei, Taiwan, probably after the messages contained in the previous section on the elders' management of the church. This message is included in this volume under the title *Concerning the Arrangement of Church Meetings*. 6. A message given in Taipei, Taiwan, in 1960. This message was originally published in the periodical *The Ministry of the Word* in September. It is included in this volume under the title *Balancing the Church Service and the Goals of the Church Service*. 7. Five messages given in Taipei, Taiwan. These messages were originally published in the periodical *The Ministry of the Word* in October 1960 through January 1961. They were previously published in a book entitled *The Law of Revival* and are included in this volume under the same title. 8. Ten messages given in New York City on October 14 through November 20.

These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Nature and Building Up of the Church*. 9. Four messages given in New York City on November 24 through 27. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Practicing the Building Up of the Church on the Proper Ground*. 10. A letter and two sets of questions and answers given in Los Angeles, California, on December 5 through 7. This section is included in this volume under the title *Fellowship in Los Angeles concerning the Ground of the Church*.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1983, volume 1 Witness Lee
The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1983, volume 1, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee from January 18 through December 21, 1983. In 1983 Brother Lee spoke eighty-five messages that were published in *Life-study of Jude*, *Life-study of 1 Peter*, *Life-study of Exodus*, *Life-study of 1, 2, and 3 John*, *Life-study of Leviticus*, *Life-study of James*, and *Life-study of Mark*. These Life-study messages are not included in *The Collected Works of Witness Lee*. During the first week in January Brother Lee was in Irving, Texas. He then traveled to Anaheim, California, and except for a one-day visit to Long Beach, California, he remained in Anaheim until the end of the third week in April. Brother Lee then returned to Irving and remained there until the middle of May. During this period he visited Houston, Texas, for a weekend conference. From Irving he traveled to Europe and ministered in Stuttgart, Germany, until the end of May. At the end of his time in Germany, Brother Lee also visited Tübingen. At the beginning of June Brother Lee returned to the

United States, visiting New York City during the first week in June and then traveling to Irving and remaining there for two weeks before proceeding to Anaheim. Brother Lee remained in Anaheim until the middle of July, and then he visited Berkeley and San Jose, California, before returning to Anaheim at the end of July. From the beginning of August until the end of the third week in November Brother Lee ministered in Anaheim. He then traveled to Irving and remained in Irving until he returned to Anaheim at the beginning of 1984. The contents of this volume are divided into nine sections, as follows: 1. Ten messages given in Anaheim, California, and Irving, Texas, on January 18 through June 13. These messages were previously published in a nine-chapter book entitled Practical Talks to the Elders and are included in this volume under the same title. 2. Four messages given in Anaheim, California, on January 20 through February 10. These messages are included in this volume under the title Fellowship with Serving Ones. 3. Six messages given in Anaheim, California, on January 23 through August 14. These messages are included in this volume under the title Fellowship concerning the Enjoyment of Christ and a Practical Way for the Lord's Recovery. 4. Five messages given in Chinese in Anaheim, California, on February 11 through 13. They were previously published in

a book entitled The Five Great Mysteries in the Bible and are included in this volume under the same title. 5. Nine messages given in Chinese in Anaheim, California, on February 20 through April 17. They were previously published in a book entitled The Subjective Experience of the Indwelling Christ and are included in this volume under the same title. 6. Five messages given in Chinese in Anaheim, California, on February 22 and 23. They are included in this volume under the title The Central Vision and the Unique Ministry. 7. Four messages given in Chinese in Anaheim, California, in February, March, and October. The date of the first message is unknown; the second through fourth messages were given on March 7 and 31 and October 22. The four messages are included in this volume under the title The Chinese-speaking Meeting and the Coordination of the Body. 8. Eleven messages given in Irving, Texas, on April 22 through December 18. They are included in this volume under the title Miscellaneous Messages Given to the Church in Irving. 9. Nine messages given in various gatherings of elders and responsible brothers in Irving, Texas, on April 29 through December 21. These are included in this volume under the title Perfecting the Saints to Preach the Gospel, Present the Truth, Minister Life, and Walk according to the Spirit in Order to Bear the Testimony of Jesus.
